- ü In the 10/40 window in the heart of West Africa.
- ü Former French colony.
- ü Twenty times the size of Austria.
- ü Fifth-poorest nation in the world.
- ü Average annual income \$190.
- ü Two thirds (semi)desert.
- ü Two thirds farming.
- ü Two thirds of its 13 million people under the poverty line.
- ü Only Muslim nation with religious freedom.
- ü 90% Muslim, 9% pagan.
- ü Half the population under 15.
- ü Child sacrifices, trafficking, forced labor.
- ü Life expectancy 47 years.
- ü Women and children not valued.
- ü 1.5 out of 4 children never turn 5.
- ü Polygamy, female circumcision, forced child marriages.
- ü Few churches, and often dead.

# STREET CHILDREN

The capital of Bamako has thousands of street children.



Every Muslim family gives one boy away to a Muslim teacher - often when they are only 5 years old - where they have to memorize the Quran at night, and beg for money during the day. They don't get food and get beaten frequently. Many of the boys run away from their teachers fighting to survive on the streets.



For four years we had a weekly program for the kids until we started letting them sleep on our base in September 2008. They get dinner and breakfast, learn to read and write in their language, and learn more about Jesus. Those that want to get off the street and live for Jesus are taken into our house as our own kids.

We now have 12 children from 1 to 19 years of age, and as soon as we have more room, others will follow.

# REACHING MALI

CAM has gone from one to eight churches in the past 3 years.

- Base in Bamako, planted Nov 2004
- Dio church joined us in March 2007
- One planted in Sotoly in May 2007
- One planted in Goro in May 2007
- One planted in Bamabougou in Nov 2007
- One planted in Diago in May 2008
- One planted in Dra in Nov 2008
- One planted in Sebeninkoro in June 2009



Our goal is to plant a strong base church in every one of the eight regions in Mali. That base church

then takes responsibility to expand God's kingdom into their whole region by planting churches in every village by means of movies, preaching, signs, miracles and wonders.

On our base we will raise up and train church planters to go out and expand God's kingdom.

Over the past 3 years we have seen hundreds of people healed and saved. Praise God!


